

SECTION 1:

1. **ALL cattle must be accompanied by their passport and cts where applicable. All cattle born after January 1998 must be double tagged to satisfy current legislation. If presented with an incorrect passport or tag(s), an offence has been committed (up to £5000 fine) and the carcass will NOT be passed for human consumption.**
2. **ALL cattle, whatever age, must be presented with clean (clipped if necessary) belly, brisket, flank and hips to MHS Cleanliness score 1 or 2. If not they will be rejected for slaughter, with no exceptions and returned at your own cost.**
3. **Please note: to qualify as SCOTCH, cattle must be Farm Assured in Scotland from birth. To qualify for CERTIFIED ABERDEEN ANGUS premia, cattle must fall into target grades and Registered Angus Sire details must be completed on form when cattle are presented at abattoir.**
4. **Before sending OTM cattle to the abattoir, please confirm which day and at what time they are to arrive.**
