1. Sheep/Lambs have resided on Farm assured holdings for the last 60 days (last farm a minimum of 20 days)
2. The animals listed above are fit for transport. (The law provides that an animal shall be unfit to be transported if it is diseased, ill, injured, deformed, weak, emaciated, fatigued or in the last 2 weeks of gestation)
3. All animals should be presented in a clean condition; any animals that do not meet the required standard will be penalized
4. Each animal must be properly identified and healthy as far as you can judge.
5. Each animal or, where appropriate, each lot of animals must be accompanied by the relevant food chain information from the holding of provenance.
6. Each animal or, where appropriate, each lot of animals must not come from a holding or an area subject to a movement prohibition or other restriction for reasons of animal or public health, except when the competent authority so permits.
7. No Quinolones and 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> generation Cephalosporins have been administered to these animals, for more information please contact your local livestock teams
8. All withdrawal periods have been adhered to.

#### **ABP UK Welsh Lamb Declaration**

1. I understand and confirm that the livestock listed have been reared in accordance to the requirements for ABP UK.
2. Sheep/ lambs have been born and reared in Wales and have resided on Welsh farm assured holdings for the entirety of their lives. The lambs are under 12 months of age and have not been bred from. The sheep have been extensively reared and fed predominately on grass.

#### **ABP UK West Country Lamb Declaration**

1. I understand and confirm that the livestock listed have been reared in accordance to the requirements for ABP UK.
2. Sheep/ lambs have been born, reared and finished in the West Country; Cornwall, Devon, Dorset, Gloucestershire, Somerset and Wiltshire
3. The lambs are under 12 months of age.
4. During their lifetime have been fed on minimum 70% forage based diet and have received a suitable period of grazing, typically 2 months. Supplements may have been fed at weaning and finishing, ingredients and purchasing records have been maintained on the animal feeding log

#### **Free Range Declaration**

1. I understand and confirm that the livestock listed have been reared in accordance to the requirements for ABP UK.
2. The animals listed have been allowed to satisfy their behavioral needs, had free moving access to pasture/fodder and have not been tethered throughout their life.
3. If housed on a temporary basis, whether for adverse weather conditions, lambing or other reasons; animals have had access to a rest area with adequate space, bedding, fresh feed, water, fresh air and ventilation.
4. Animals have not been kept in isolation except for breeding males and ewes at lambing
